SBooks and SIDs are only good to prove a seafarer's working condition, and that he is either entering or departing the country in connection to a vessel at a certain port;
- 2. Crew from signatory countries of ILO C-185 that maintain agreements with Brazil for VISA exemption (case of BOSNIA, CROATIA, FRANCE, GEORGIA, HUNGARY, MOLDOVA, MONTENEGRO, SPAIN, THE PHILIPPINES, amongst others), will be required Passport and the SID to access the country (for a period of 180 days). In case these Nationals are not in possession of SID, the SBook will be required and only a 90 days stay will be granted:

- Kindly be informed that it is possible to arrange crew change operations on weekends and holidays.
- Embark/disembark at outer anchorage only during the daylight hours.
- Embark it is allowed at nighttime. However, disembark are only allowed during Customs working hours, up to 1800hrs and during weekends and holidays.

- During the weekend we can embark the joiners but no Disembark is allowed due to the lack of Customs to inspect the luggage.

It's important to highlight that each Brazilian port has its own interpretation on the Health Authority rules in force, meaning that all above instructions can be changed anytime without any pre advise. Sultrade is aware to keep you posted immediately in case of any further changes on the above instructions.

Dear Capt Nikos,

With regards to yours below, we have already consulted both, Class and UTM service engineer regarding costs involved at Praia Mole (or OPL anchorage after discharging) and requested them to send a new proposal considering both situations.

As per DPC rules, inspection has to be carried out with all holds empty and ready to be inspected, although on a few cases we have succeeded in arranging the survey during last discharging moments, as part of holds will be empty and ready to be inspected prior to the completion. In such case, and depending on time of completion, surveyors could unmoor with the vessel and finalize the inspection once vessel anchors, which would minimize costs.

Otherwise, will have to await completion of discharge and have her anchoring at OPL Vitoria, for the inspection.

Understand that her schedule at Praia Mole Coal Pier is:

PRAIA MOLE - COAL ETA 08.04 WP UCE ETB 17.04 AGW WP (TBC). ETD 24.04 AGW WP (TBC).

Based on above and estimating an ideal situation, surveyors could be on board in the afternoon of Apr 23rd and complete the inspection on Apr 24th right after vessel finishing her discharge, and before pilot boarding time, as to avoid having to use boat and disembark at OPL.

The condition survey consists of three key aspects:

- 1. **Documentary review** to ensure compliance with international conventions and regulations that the Brazilian government has signed and to verify the class status with any outstanding recommendations, along with evidence of ship registry, ownership, and P&I insurance, including pollution and wreck removal covers.
- Visual structural inspection of internal structures and compartments, cargo holds, ballast tanks, double
 bottom and top side tanks (wing tanks) and fore peak tanks at the surveyor's discretion. This includes spot
 thickness gauging of various points of the ship structure and plating based on measurements recorded at
 the last dry-docking.
- 3. **Watertightness check** of cargo holds or tanks on the main deck, with particular attention to the coamings, hatch covers, manholes, and their closing devices and sealing gaskets.

The inspection can be carried out in daylight at any Brazilian port, regardless of whether it is the port of loading. The ship must be anchored in sheltered waters or safely moored alongside a berth, fully unloaded, de-ballasted, gasfree, and with the ballast tanks ventilated and ready for inspection, ensuring compliance with the applicable safety measures.

Attaching to this an estimated cost for the inspection to be carried out at Praia Mole, as per above. Variation on cost may occur, case it is not possible to disembark surveyors before vessel unmooring.

Navy DPC establishes on their rule NORMAM 203, that any bulker aged 18+ years (counting as from keel laid date, and understood that MV OHIBA I had her keel laid on Dec 2004, thus prior loading any ore cargo (whose SG is

higher than 1,78 t/m3) has to compulsorily be subject to a condition survey carried-out by a Class Society (rather than the one classifying the vessel) recognized by Brazilian Navy, and during such inspection plate's thickness of vessel to be tested by a USTM expert, just like the survey she passed last year.

Survey has to be requested in advance to DPC, and vessel's holds are to be empty and ready for inspection. It may be done at AÇU PORT anchorage and will be valid for another period of a year. We may arrange the survey and hire local recognized Class and USTM.

Normally said inspections on board vessels lasts some 8 or 10 hr (including thickness measurements of approx. 30% of vessel's plating).

Costs involved may vary from the different Class Societies accredited by the Brazilian Navy for this task, and in this case AWS Class has charged USD 3,500.00 (normal days) and USTM technicians (End Zaya) will charge USD 2,450.00 including mob/demob costs. Our handling fees for coordinating this task are of USD 250.00. Have attached both proposals to this message for your prompt and ready knowledge and use.

It's although, necessary to consider that Class Surveyors and service engineer for USTM will board vessel at OPL anchorage for such DPC Inspection/Condition Survey. It will be required that vessel to anchor at safe anchorage area prior to berthing, so that she may be inspected/cleared at Navy's DPC satisfaction prior to being authorized to load. It is also necessary, vessel to be in Free Pratique which understand Charterers Agents will request in advance of her arrival (expected on April 21st – which is a National Holiday). If she will not call AÇU on a commercial call, pls let us know order calculate calling costs as well.

Case you do require any further info, pls do not hesitate in contacting this office.

According to the Navy Rule (NORMAM 203) these services have to be requested at least 48 hr in advance, so just to anticipate procedures, pls note that copies of following documents will be required prior to inspection being done:
