Dear Mr. Ilias Marios Protopapas, good day.

Considering Greek, Germany and Romania citizens do not require Consular VISAS for entry admittance to Brazil, although technician/superintendent will come on a business travel, it will be required access to port facilities and the vessel, a pre-clearance for him will be required. We will need to send a Letter of Guarantee to the airlines.

On his arrival at the Brazilian airport, technician/superintendent must declare to the attending Immigration Officer that he is not a tourist, but on a BUSINESS TRIP, otherwise, we will not be able to arrange his entry clearance to access the port. His passport must be stamped with business code 102/03.

We will arrange hotel accommodation and transportation for the technicians as requested.

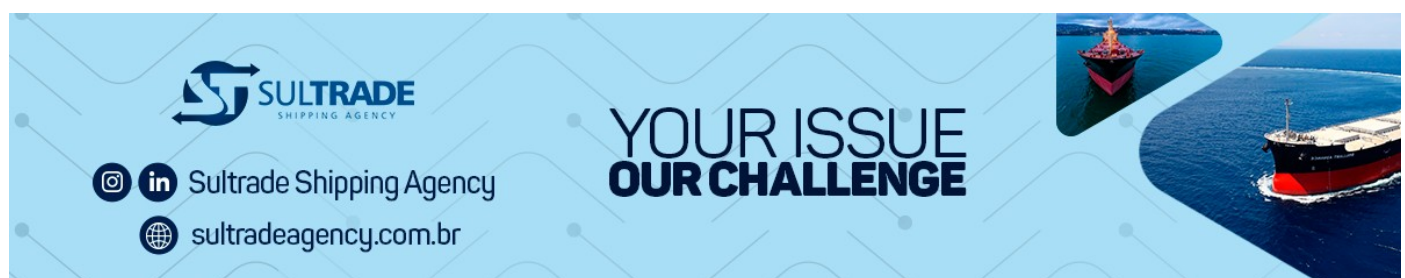
